قَالَ يَقُومُ أَرَاءَ بَيْتِمْ إِنْ كُنْتُ عَلَى بَيِّنَةٍ مِّن رَّبِّي وَرَزَقَنِي مِنْهُ رِزْقًا حَسَنًا وَمَا أُرِيدُ أَنْ أُخَالِفَكُمْ
إِلَىٰ مَا أَنهَنكُم عَنْهُ إِنْ أُرِيدُ إِلَّا الْإِصْلَاحَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتُ وَمَا تَوْفِيقِي إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ عَلَيْهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ
وَإِلَيْهِ أُنِيبُ ﴿٨٨﴾

They said, 'O Shu'ayb, does your worship require that we abandon what our fathers have been worshipping, **or that we should not do with our wealth whatever we wish?** You are indeed [a] gentle and sensible [person].'

He said, 'O my people! Have you considered, should I stand on a manifest proof from my Lord, who has provided me a good provision from Himself?

I do not wish to oppose you by what I forbid you.
